


F Rating — 3 Hr
T Rating — 1/2 Hr
L Rating At Ambient — 2.8 CFM/sq ft
L Rating At 400 F — Less Than 1 CFM/sq ft



- 1. **Floor or Wall Assembly** Min 4-1/2 in. thick reinforced lightweight or normal weight (100<u>150</u> pcf) concrete. Wall may also be constructed of any UL Classified **Concrete Blocks***. Max diam of opening is 4 in. See **Concrete Blocks** (CAZT) category in the Fire Resistance Directory for names of manufacturers.
- 2. **Nonmetallic Pipe** One nonmetallic pipe to be centered within the firestop system. A nom annular space of 7/8 in. is required within the firestop system. Pipe to be rigidly supported on both sides of floor or wall assembly. The following types and sizes of nonmetallic may be used:
 - A. **Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) Pipe** Nom 2 in. diam (or smaller) Schedule 40 PVC pipe for use in closed (process or supply) or vented (drain, waste or vent) piping systems.
 - B. Chlorinated Polyvinyl Chloride (CPVC) Pipe Nom 2 in. diam (or smaller) SDR 17 CPVC pipe for use in closed (process or supply) or vented (drain, waste or vent) piping systems.
- 3. **Firestop System** The firestop system shall consist of the following:
 - A. **Packing Material** (Optional) Foam backer rod firmly packed into opening as a permanent form. Packing material to be recessed from top surface of floor or from both surfaces of wall as required to accommodate the required thickness of fill material.
 - B. Fill, Void or Cavity Material* Sealant Min 2 in. thickness of fill material applied within the annulus, flush with top surface of floor or with both surfaces of wall.
